AREAS OF WORK

EDUCATION - Balwadi for 100+ children in the age group 3-6 years and tuitions/ after school support for 50 children from the informal settlements of Pratiksha Nagar, Sion Koliwada.



HEALTH - KJ Somaiya Hospital in the vicinity runs the Urban Health Training Centre (UHTC) in association with RKSS in service of the women and children of the informal settlements.





SKILL DEVELOPMENT - RKSS works with street artisans and homemakers in the niehborhood and develop them into skilled, vocationally trained, and market-ready wage earners and entrepreneurs.





WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT - RKSS also runs several workshops like Gappa Goshti sessions on women and child health. We run free computer and financial literacy classes for women. We also help the local artisans and tailors trained by us to make goods for pop up stores of RKSS.

Report On Urban Health Training Centre

Urban Health Training Center (UHTC) of K.J. Somaiya Medical College and Research Centre is located at RKSS Building, Pratiksha Nagar, Sion. It operates in collaboration with Ramakrishna Sarada Samiti (RKSS). It caters to Urban slum areas of Shastri Nagar, Transit camp buildings, Almeida Compound, Gautam Nagar and Panchsheel Nagar. The population covered is approximately 43000.

The UHTC functions from Monday to Friday, 9:30 am to 4:00 pm excluding public holidays. It provides various services like General OPD services with drug dispensing facilities, Specialty clinics like Under Five, Well Woman, Hypertension and Diabetes Mellitus, Physiotherapy, Immunization, Counselling, Ophthalmology clinic, and Dermatology clinic. Laboratory services are provided twice a week.

The daily OPD activities conducted at UHTC are given below in the table -

General OPD

On all 5 days i.e. from Monday to Friday morning, in General OPD, patients are examined and given adequate treatment. If needed, laboratory investigations are advised or patients are referred to KJ Somaiya Hospital for further management. General dietary and relevant health advice are also given to patients.

Physiotherapy OPD

Patients referred on other days for physiotherapy are examined by Physiotherapist of KJSH.

Patients are taught various exercises according to their ailments to be done at home. Referrals can be given if specific treatment is required for the patient.

Well Woman Clinic: It includes

- 1. Clinical breast examination
 - a) CBE by qualified doctors (once a year for every woman)
 - b) Teaching the methodology to the woman to do self-breast examination every month.
 - c) Referral to Surgery OPD KJSH and assistance to the woman till final treatment (in case of abnormal CBE)
- 2. Gynecological consultation including Pap smear
- 3. Provision of Family planning services CuT insertion, OCPs, Condoms.
- 4. Random blood sugar estimation and Hemoglobin measurement.
- 5. Height, weight and blood pressure measurement.

HTDM clinic

- Examination of patients for any complications of Hypertension and Diabetes mellitus with monthly follow up.
- Provision of monthly medicines
- FBS and PPBS examination of DM patients every 3 months or earlier if necessary.
- S. Creatinine and lipid profile done every 6 months.
- Ophthalmology reference to rule out complications
- Advice and counselling for healthy lifestyle.
- Referral to KJSH if required.

Under 5 clinic

- Growth monitoring of children under 5 years of age with regular follow up
- Identification of malnourished children
- Treatment of illnesses by Pediatrician.
- Immunization activities on every 2nd and 4th Thursday. Dietary counselling specially to mothers of malnourished children
- General health advice to mothers regarding immunization, hygiene, breast feed, etc.

Ophthalmology OPD

- Examination of patients for refractive errors
- Ophthalmological consultation by qualified Ophthalmologist with provision of treatment
- Referral to KJSH if required.

Community Health Activities

- We conduct health camps taking into account prevalent public health problems, in urban slum community once in every two months. From April 2019 to March 2020, 17 camps are organized by Department of Community Medicine, covering total 375 beneficiaries.
- We organize school health camps for health checkup of school children at Karmaveer
 Bhaurao School once in a year. Last health checkup was done in Jan 2020, which included
 275 boys and 244 girls i.e. total 519 children.
- In addition, we do health checkup of preschool children enrolled in RKSS once every three months. Last health check-up was done in January 2019, covering total 215 children.
- If a child needs treatment or a referral, we provide them adequate treatment or refer for further management to UHTC or KJ Somaiya hospital if needed.
- We counsel the teachers and parents regarding the health care of children.
- An informative session on various postal schemes was conducted for the parents of balwadi children with the help of staff from the postal department on 21/09/2019
- Health talk on personal hygiene was given during parents meeting in Ramakrishna Sarada Samiti on 20/07/2019. Importance of personal hygiene was emphasized. Six steps of hand wash were shown to the parents. Health talk on what is diarrhoea, its causes, symptoms and treatment emphasizing on Home available liquids, Homemade ORS and WHO ORS was given.

Child to Child Programme in Community

Child to Child and Community Programme was conducted in BMC School in Pratiksha Nagar, Sion. Total 10 sessions were conducted. 5 sessions for 5th standard on personal and dental hygiene were conducted and for 6th standard, 5 sessions on environmental hygiene and diarrhoea were conducted. Sessions were interactive with songs and games. Discussion was done on topic with the help of PowerPoint presentations, videos and flipcharts.

Counselling OPD

Social health problems such as familial issues, employment problems, addictions etc. are dealt with in this OPD by Medical Social worker on every Monday afternoon.

Laboratory investigations on Tuesday and Friday morning

- Fasting and postprandial blood sugar
- CBC
- S. Creatinine
- Lipid profile
- Peripheral smear for malarial parasite
- Liver function tests


Opportunistic screening


- All patients who are >25 yrs. of age (not known case of HTN/ DM) are screened for Hypertension and Diabetes mellitus by measurement of blood pressure and RBS on glucometer respectively.
- Those who have BP >140/90 mm Hg are advised to follow up for next two days for BP monitoring. If BP is consistently high are started on treatment for HTN labelling him/her as a new patient.
- Those who have RBS>140 mg/dl are advised to follow up for FBS and GTT measurement and are managed as per the reports.

Home visits and Phone follow up

- Home visits are done for follow up of under five children and ANC women on every Monday and Friday respectively by community health worker.
- Phone follow up and reminders are given to well women clinic and under 5 clinic beneficiaries on Tuesdays and Fridays.
- Defaulters of HTDM clinic are followed up on phone and home visits by community health worker to prevent drop out.
